- ✓ put worms and their castings in our gardens so they can help fertilize the plants, help break-up the soil so that it can retain water, and help plants grow faster & bigger!

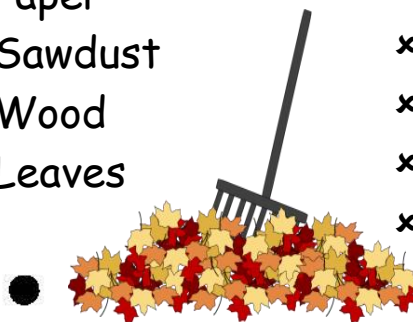


What you can add to the Worm Bin:

- ✓ Crushed egg shells
- ✓ Fruit skin/covering
- ✓ Grass clippings
- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Sawdust
- ✓ Wood
- ✓ Leaves
