

Autumn Joy Sedum

Hylotelephium spectabile (formerly Sedum spectabile) 'Autumn Joy'

Plant Description – non-native, herb/wildflower, deciduous, perennial

Height: up to 2 ft Width/Spread: up to 2 ft





<u>Leaves</u>

Shape: elliptical **Arrangement:** opposite, whorled

Margin: serrate Form: simple

Leaf Description: dull green to blue-green leaves up to 3 inches long are fleshy and flat; upper leaves are sessile (attached directly to stem without stalk); grow on fleshy stems

Flower/Bloom

Flower Color: pink, burgundy In Bloom: Aug - Oct

Flower Shape: stellate (star-shaped)

Flower(s) Description: flower is radially symmetrical with 4-5 petals, ½ inch across, in dense rounded flower heads 3-4 inches across; flower color changes from pink to dark reddish-brown with age





Fruits & Seeds

Spreads via: Seeds **Seed Type:** Dry seed pod

Seed Season: Fall - Winter

Fruit and Seed Description: small capsule (a chamber within the fruit)

and splits open when ripe

Ecological Benefits

Food source for Butterflies, Other Pollinators, and Other Birds

Maintenance Notes

Dormant in winter; prefers average watering (water two times per week during the summer and once per week during the rest of the year.)
