

### **Bronze Fennel**

Foeniculum vulgare

**Plant Description** – native, herb/wildflower, deciduous, perennial

Height: 4 - 6 ft Width/Spread: 1.5 - 3 ft





## <u>Leaves</u>

Shape: linear Arrangement: alternate

Margin: entire Form: compound

**Leaf Description:** leaves are finely divided, feathery, yellow-green, aromatic, with needle-like linear segments; foliage is purplish-bronze,

fading to dark green with age

# Flower/Bloom

Flower Color: yellow In Bloom: Jun - Jul

Flower Shape: tubulate

Flower(s) Description: 20-50 small flowers on short pedicels (stalks) in

umbrella-like cluster at end of hollow stem





#### **Fruits & Seeds**

**Spreads via:** Seeds **Seed Type:** Dry seed pod

Seed Season: Late Summer - Fall

**Fruit and Seed Description:** seeds are aromatic, small, greenish brown to yellowish brown, oblong ovals with 5 prominent ridges running lengthwise; dry but does not split open when ripe

#### Food source for Butterflies, Caterpillars, Native Bees, and Other Pollinators

#### **Maintenance Notes**

Prefers average watering (water two times per week during the summer and once per week during the rest of the year)
