

### **Rose Vervain**

Glandularia canadensis

**Plant Description** – native, herb, evergreen, perennial

**Height:** 0.5 – 1.5 ft **Width/Spread:** 1 - 2 ft





### **Leaves**

**Shape:** ovate **Arrangement:** opposite

Margin: serrate & lobed Form: simple

Leaf Description: 4-inch long, dark green, dissected on each side of the

central axis, and may be hairy

## Flower/Bloom

Flower Color: pink, rosy pink, lavender In Bloom: Feb - Sep - Oct

Flower Shape: tubulate

**Flower(s) Description:** fragrant flowers in 2-inch, flat-topped clusters are produced at the top of the branch tips; flowers have 5 petals





#### **Fruits & Seeds**

**Spreads via:** Seeds & Rhizomes **Seed Type:** Dry seed pod

Fruit and Seed Description: acorn-like shaped seed pad; small,

cylindrical, brown seeds

# **Ecological Benefits**

Food source for Butterflies, rabbits, and deer

#### **Maintenance Notes**

Prefers average watering (water two times per week during the summer and once per week during the rest of the year)
